At Catherine's, we're committed to providing access to high quality, affordable, and compassionate healthcare for the underserved in our community. We treat the whole person by offering holistic services: medical, dental, behavioral health, and health support. Like us, you also believe that everyone has a right to dignified healthcare, regardless of their background or ability to pay.

Our services and your values make for the perfect partnership. As a nonprofit Federally Qualified Health Center, we rely on the support of the community, and you can rest assured that your generosity is truly making a difference for your neighbors. In 2022, Catherine's experienced monumental expansion as we worked toward our goal of serving 19,000 patients throughout Kent County. We opened several new sites in new communities, offering our award winning, high-quality care to more people.

This expansion is exciting and highlights the critical need for accessible healthcare. To address that need, Catherine's partners with individuals and businesses like you to provide care for anyone who happens to walk through our doors. Throughout 2023, we plan to host several events to raise necessary funds, introduce more people to health equity, and establish partnerships with other reputable organizations to address the systematic issues in healthcare today. The funding focus for 2023 is Substance Use Disorder (SUD) treatment. Catherine's recognizes this service as a rapidly growing need and has developed provider training and new service lines to best serve patients who are currently using substances within a harm reduction model. Below are the events we plan to host in 2023:

- Open Doors Dinner: Our annual fundraising event, this is the first year we are
 hosting it as a dinner in the hopes of being able to engage more community
 members. The Open Doors Dinner features an update from Catherine's
 leadership, a patient keynote, and an opportunity for approximately 250 guests
 (additional guests may attend virtually) to support the mission. The 2023 Open
 Doors Dinner is scheduled for Tuesday, May 2nd at Frederik Meijer Gardens &
 Sculpture Park.
- <u>Coffee and Conversations:</u> These monthly tours allow up to 10 potential, new, and existing supporters to learn more about Catherine's in an hour-long session.

Each month, tours take place at a different Catherine's location and focus on a different topic in order to provide relevant information to the public regarding community health.

Health Equity Community Panel: New in 2023, Catherine's will engage the
community by hosting a thought leader event in partnership with other local
organizations and subject experts. In alignment with the funding focus of SUD
treatment, this September speaker panel with feature Catherine's and partners
in Grand Rapids to discuss the current and future state of SUD treatment at the
community-health level. This event will be open to 200 guests in-person, as well
as virtually.

For these events to be as successful as possible and to bring in more support for this work, we humbly ask you to consider being an event sponsor. As a sponsor, you will receive recognition at each of Catherine's events. We intend to continue creating the best integrated care for Kent County, but creation requires collaboration and partnership.
