FROM OUR LEADERSHIP

Dear Partners and Friends,

We are delighted to present Catherine's Health Center's 2024 Annual Report, an overview of our achievements last year and our exciting plans for the future. Your unwavering support has been instrumental in helping us make significant strides in providing quality healthcare to our community.

In 2024, we accomplished several key achievements that enhanced our service to patients. We implemented the 340B contract pharmacy program, which improved access and affordability of essential medications for patients in need. Additionally, we expanded place-based healthcare for the unhoused, ensuring medical services for all. We also improved integrated behavioral healthcare at Catherine's Health Center to address comprehensive patient needs and opened new services for students at Crestwood Middle School and Godfrey Elementary School.

As we look ahead to 2025, we are excited to share our ambitious goals that will further our mission of providing accessible and high-quality healthcare:

- We plan to open our first school-based health clinic at Harrison Park Academy, which will include on-site primary medical and counseling services year-round for any youth ages 3-21. This initiative aims to reduce barriers to healthcare access for children and promote their overall health and academic success.
- We will launch a street medicine team with a van, providing healthcare directly to individuals experiencing homelessness wherever they are.
- We are committed to expanding our behavioral health and substance use disorder treatment programs. By increasing our capacity to address these critical issues, we aim to support the mental and physical well-being of our community members.
- We are extending our operating hours at the Mel Trotter clinic to enhance access to medical care, behavioral health services, and dental hygiene.

We are deeply grateful for your continued support and partnership. Together, we can achieve these goals and make a lasting impact on the health and wellness of our community.




