

As you may have heard in the <u>news</u>, Congress is considering major changes to the Medicaid program, a program that you, your friends, or your family might rely on.

60% of our patients here at
Catherine's Health Center get their
health insurance through Medicaid
and rely on it for access to healthcare, as

do one in four Michigan residents statewide.

Medicaid provides coverage for 38% of births in Michigan, 2 in 5 children, 3 in 5 nursing home residents, and 3 in 8 working-age adults with disabilities. And, like hospitals and nursing homes, reimbursement from Medicaid is a critical part of how we sustain the services we provide at Catherine's for everyone in our community.

If you are concerned about how changes to Medicaid will impact our community, we could use your help telling federal elected officials how challenging these cuts would be to you and your neighbors.

Please take one or more of these actions to make your voice heard:
